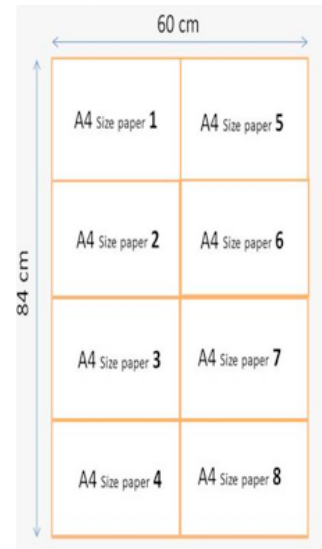
Abstract

An abstract is a brief summary of the presentation and should be original, informative and descriptive. It should be relevant to the theme of the poster session and should allow the readers to understand the contents of the presentation quickly. In general, it should describe introduction and objective of the subject and its results in brief, with some recommendations (if applicable). Any authentic data presented in the poster should be permitted or verified by the related authority of the institution where the study was conducted and the author(s) should be responsible for any conflict arising from the data or contents that are shown on the poster. All the submitted abstracts will be published in the Seminar Proceedings, which will be distributed during the seminar, and will also be available online for wider circulation. The abstract should not contain more than 200 words.

Instructions for Poster Presentation at the SONSIK 6th Educational Seminar

- A. Each poster should contain Introduction, Objectives, Materials & Methods, Results, Conclusions, Recommendations (if applicable) and related references.
- B. Poster size & Format should be as shown on the right side.
- C. We expect posters to be informative, educational and interesting.
- D. Authors can bring their posters by themselves or can request the Organizing committee to PRINT OUT the posters. For print support, poster files should be sent to doc.sonsik@gmail.com by 8th February 2018 and should be mentioned clearly during the abstract submission.



E. Criteria for the selection of Best Poster Awards at the SONSIK 6th Educational Seminar:

1. Best Poster Awards will be presented to few posters presented at the SONSIK 6th Educational Seminar.
2. Only posters with abstracts submitted for the Seminar Proceedings and presented at the seminar are eligible for the Best Poster Award.
3. The Scientific Committee will evaluate all the eligible posters using the criteria of “Quality of Presentation”, “Content”, “Visual Presentation”, “Interactions with the selection committee” and “Impact” on the SONSIK Community” for the selection of Best Poster Awards.
4. All the best poster award-winning presenters (the first author in case of multi-authored poster) will receive a Certificate of Best Poster and a Cash prize of 30,000 KRW.
5. In case of any conflict, the decision made by the Scientific Committee will be final.
